

You will see a screen that looks like this:



On the right-hand side, you enter your login information in the LOGIN box that looks like this:

Your Username will be **firstnamelastname all one word, all lowercase letters.**

Your Password will be: **Capital first letter of first name, lowercase first letter of lastname, and lunch ID Number.**

**Example: Username: johnsmith** (no spaces)  
**Password: Js123456**

Next, click the LOGIN button. The Moodle Orientation Course will appear as a course to which you are assigned. If you get an error, double check to make sure you typed your information in correctly, using the format above.

**You are to complete the Moodle Orientation Course on Friday, April 3, 2020. The orientation course MUST be completed before you begin academic instruction on Monday, April 6, 2020.** The orientation course explains how the site works, and how to upload and submit your course work.
